

## UPDATED CPCC DUAL ENROLLMENT INFORMATION-11th & 12th GRADE ONLY

CMS has changed their CPCC policy. Students **CAN** take some graduation requirements at CPCC. See chart below.

CMS Graduation Requirement	CPCC Course Equivalency
American History	HIS131 <b>AND</b> HIS132
4th Math Class	MAT143, MAT152, MAT171, MAT172
World Language (not a grad rqmt)	See below
All other graduation requirements	Must be taken at AKHS

**We will now have TWO Change Weeks:** One for AK class adjustments and one for CPCC class adjustments.

- **Change Week March 10-14 will ONLY be for AK based changes**
  - Ex: Changing course levels, changing alternates, etc.
- **CPCC Change Week (NEW): April 28-30**
  - Rising Juniors will show proof of specific CPCC class enrollment before asking to drop classes at AK.
    - Ex: Must be enrolled in HIS 131 to drop Honors American History/APUSH
  - All students will produce signed Early Release Contract before asking to drop classes at AK for ER/LA

### CPCC History Information & Policies

- Students must take TWO History classes at CPCC (HIS 131 & HIS 132) to count as their 1 American History requirement for graduation.
- Students must take HIS131 **AND** HIS132 in their 11th grade year.

### CPCC Math Information & Policies

- Students can take their 4th math graduation requirement at CPCC.
  - 4th Math Graduation Requirement Course Options:
    - MAT171 (Precalculus Algebra)
    - MAT172 (Precalculus Trigonometry)
    - MAT143 (Quantitative Literacy)
    - MAT152 (Statistical Methods I)
- If you take Precalculus at CPCC (MAT171 **AND** MAT172), we encourage you to continue with CPCC math courses for curriculum continuity.

### CPCC World Languages Information & Policies

- Students will take a placement test before being able to select a higher level language course.
- It is unlikely that CPCC will allow CMS students to start any higher than 112 (equivalent to Level 2 in CMS).
